Standard Treatment Guideline (STG) is systematically developed statements that assist prescribers choose on appropriate treatments for specific clinical problems.

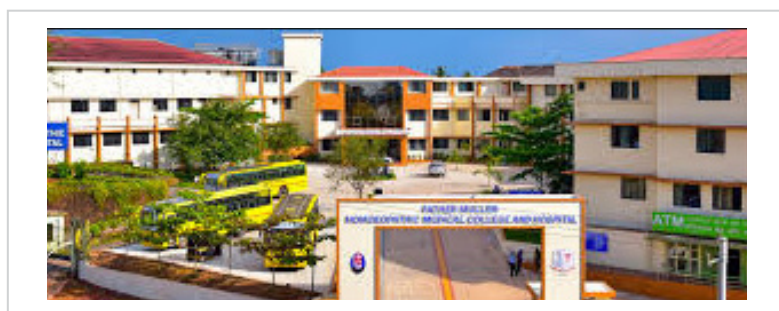
"If one homeopath could give relief to the patient with one particular medicine during a specific potency and dosage then that would be repeated all homeopaths" – says Dr S G Biju.
